If there is a particular course you wish to attend please see me. All training courses must be approved by me or Chief Segars. That is a SCFA rule as well as our own.

Expect an email from Target Solutions around the second week of March with your online training schedule. I will send an active 911 text after the email is sent.

We run calls every day. If you go more than a 48-hour period without receiving a message on Active 911 then something is wrong. Please investigate and correct the situation.

We need our members to be engaged in our department. If you are dormant please become active. The last thing we want to do is dismiss members but you only have value when active in our department. We are working on a new stand by roster requirement for volunteers. This will incorporate required training so your time will be well spent.
